GOOD FAITH CLINIC

Good Faith Clinic is a free clinic created by Doctors David and Jenny Byrd to minister to the health needs of the Athens/ McMinn County area that do not have any health insurance or Tenncare. The clinic is completely staffed by volunteers from Athens Regional Medical Center and at large from the Athens area. Staff includes nurses, administrators, pharmacy personnel, and various helpers during the hours the clinic is service. The clinic is currently open two Thursday evenings each month. It begins operation at 6:00 treating patients with non-invasive diagnosis . . . and providing medicines for most circumstances. The clinic is open to everyone in the Athens area.
