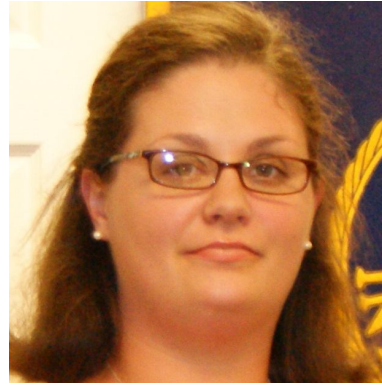
JERRI BRYANT
